## Living and Dying for One's Faith

Belief in the afterlife and in heaven is at the heart of Christian faith. In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us that at the end of our earthly life, we shall render an account of it. Those who have led evil lives will be condemned, while those who are just will join the company of the holy ones in the Heavenly Banquet.



For Saint Teresa of Avila, prayer “is nothing but friendly intercourse, and frequent solitary converse, with Him who we know loves us”. I would insist that this is true not only for a privileged few, but for all of us, for “we all have need of this silence, filled with the presence of him who is adored”. Trust-filled prayer is a response of a heart open to encountering God face to face, where all is peaceful and the quiet voice of the Lord can be heard in the midst of silence. (Gaudete et Exsultate #149)
