**RICH IN WHAT MATTERS TO GOD**

The Lord Jesus repeatedly warns us of the danger of riches, how they can blind us to the pitiful condition of the poor. The Gospel presents to us the right attitude in the example of Zacchaeus. This tax collector declares he is ready to share half of his wealth with the poor and to repay four times whatever he may have extorted from anyone.

Though short of stature, Zacchaeus has a big heart, thus winning Jesus' praise for him as a true descendant of Abraham. As we worship God today, may we realize that we store up treasures for ourselves in heaven by being "rich in what matters to God" and helping our poor brothers and sisters



**IN CONSTANT PRAYER**

Finally, though it may seem obvious, we should remember that holiness consists in a habitual openness to the transcendent, expressed in prayer and adoration. The saints are distinguished by a spirit of prayer and a need for communion with God. They find an exclusive concern with this world to be narrow and stifling, and, amid their own concerns and commitments, they long for God, losing themselves in praise and contemplation of the Lord. I do not believe in holiness without prayer, even though that prayer need not be lengthy or involve intense emotions. (Gaudete et Exsultate #147)
