**THE BOOK OF THE GOSPELS**

Because it represents Christ Himself it should be a truly beautiful object. It is carried in the entrance procession and enthroned on the Altar. During the Gospel Acclamation, it is carried in procession from the Altar to the Ambo (lectern) – this is to represent our common mission of proclaiming the Gospel to all creation.
