The Third Sunday of Advent is Gaudete Sunday.



Sunday of joy, Sunday of rejoicing. Our entrance antiphon recalls Paul’s exhortation: “Rejoice in the Lord always!” Isaiah invites God’s people to meet the Lord with joy and gladness. And to John the Baptist’s messengers, Jesus reveals that he is indeed the awaited one, the Messiah who has brought good news to the poor.
