GLORY TO THE TRINITY, THE UNDIVIDED UNITY!

Although most of our liturgical worship is addressed to the Blessed Trinity, today we are invited to honour the Tri-Personal God in a very special manner. Our limited intelligence is unable to fathom exhaustively this fundamental mystery of one God in three Persons. Nor can our frail hearts adequately reciprocate His love. There is always so much more we should know about the Trinity; so much more we should do for the love of this one God in three Persons. The biggest challenge, however, is to reproduce in ourselves and in our relationships the love, harmony, and unity that exist in and among the three Divine Persons.

Our whole life is marked by the sign of the Trinity. The Father created us in love. The Son came to the world to make it possible for us to recover our divine sonship which we lost because of sin. The Holy Spirit continues the work of the Son in the Church and in history until the Lord Jesus returns in glory. In the mystery of the Trinity— “three Persons equal in majesty, undivided in splendour, yet one Lord, one God”— our journey has its origin. The Holy Trinity is also our final goal. Someday our eyes will finally contemplate the face of God who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit

PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL - CHURCH RE-OPENING:

Bishop McGuckin has approved Sacred Heart’s COVIDSafe Plan. **Once we have all the requirements in place, to re-open**, we will advise Parishioners through the Bulletin posted on the website, Bulletin emailed to those with the email addresses, through contact with your Care and Concern Team Member, or by phone call, as to when the Church will be re-opening.

Please note that it is Fr’s Roque’s decision, and supported by the PPC, that when we are drawing up Rosters for weekend and weekday Masses to give priority to those parishioners who have identified themselves as parishioners in the Parish Survey conducted last year. If for some reason you did not complete the Survey and would like to – please see attached Registration Form. Please return completed form by either emailing it to the Parish Office, leaving it in the Presbytery letterbox, returning it to the office during opening hours or mailing it. Parishioners are deemed those who attend weekend Masses in the Parish & contribute to the life of the Parish. If unsure if you have completed a form, contact the Parish Office and if necessary, a form will be emailed/sent to you.
