The Third Sunday of Advent is called "Gaudete Sunday." "Gaudete" is the first word, in Latin, of today's Entrance Antiphon: "Gaudete in Domino semper" — "Rejoice in the Lord always." To remind people that they are preparing for the very joyful occasion of the birth of Jesus, the celebrant wears rose-colored vestments.
